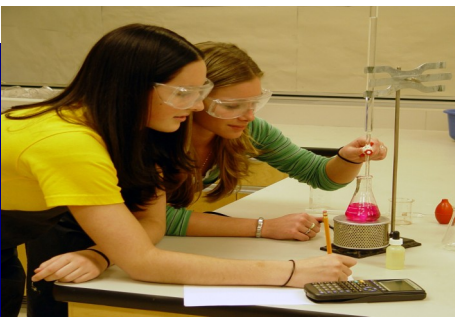

## Ohio Total Science Safety System

Based on extensive continuing national and individual state research studies by Dr. Jack A. Gerlovich and colleagues, the comprehensive training and CD-ROM programs designed to inform teachers of their professional responsibilities and to provide them the tools and confidence to address them.

A "comprehensive " safety tool designed to aid pre-service and in-service educators in locating and applying applicable federal and state laws, codes, and standards; performing and documenting safety audits; and electronic options for establishing and managing chemical storerooms. Approved chemical disposal options can also be provided. `
