

The Principals' Award for Leadership in Science Education

These awards are given to current Elementary, Middle Level, and High School principals who have demonstrated leadership in the development, implementation, and maintenance of an outstanding school science program; supported staff development in science; promoted positive relationships between the school's science program and the community; and have been advocates and leaders for the development of science process skills and positive attitudes toward science among students, parents, and teachers.

NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS

NOTES: THE NOMINATION FORM & SUMMARY MUST BE COMPLETED FOR EACH NOMINEE.
NOMINATIONS MUST BE POSTMARKED BY October 31st TO GUARENTEE CURRENT YEAR CONSIDERATION.

1. ___ Completed Nomination Form
2. ___ Summary (up to 150 words) describing why the nominee is deserving of the award, focusing on the criteria for the award which would include examples of the nominee's outstanding leadership in promoting and supporting science education.
3. ___ The completed Nominee Information Sheet
4. ___ Three sealed letters of support. The letters should provide examples of the nominee's outstanding leadership in promoting and supporting science education. One letter of support must be from the nominator, one from a teacher in the principal's current building, and the third from a colleague, supervisor, parent or other individual who knows of the principal's support of science education. The letters should address the following:
 - a. How the nominee is a leader, mentor, role model, and/or facilitator in the teaching of science.
 - b. How the nominee has supported the development and implementation of standards-based science curriculum in his or her building.
 - c. How the nominee has secured community support for the building's science program.
 - d. How the nominee has supported the science program by providing necessary teaching materials and funding.
